GAZİANTEP CASTLE

Gaziantep Castle was originally built by the Hittite kingdoms on a hill that stands high on the surrounding land. As the population and the city grew the castle became the centre of the city, standing tall above the buildings.

While the *Hittites* build a small observation point it was later expanded into a full castle by the *Roman Empire* during the 2nd and 3rd century AD, it remained this way for generations. During the reign of *Emperor Justinianus*, it was further expanded to the final size that is known today. As recently as 2000 the castle has been renovated throughout the generations. Now the castle stands as a museum to commemorate Heroism and the defence of Gaziantep against French Troops that attempted to invade after the fall of the *Ottoman Empire*.



Mor Hananyo Monastery

- **Meryemana (Virgin Mary) Church**- A **Syriac Catholic Church**, built in 1895 as the Patriarchal Church, as the Syriac Catholic see was in Mardin up until the **Assyrian genocide**.^[25]
- **Red (Surp Kevork) Church**- An **Armenian Apostolic Church** renovated in 2015^{[26][27]}
- Mor Yusuf (Surp Hovsep; St Joseph) Church - An **Armenian Catholic Church**^[25]
- Mor Behnam (Kirk Şehitler) Church - A **Syriac Orthodox Church** built in the name of Mor Behnam and Mort Saro, the son and daughter of a ruler; dates back to 569 AD.^[28]
- Mor Hirmiz Church - A **Chaldean Catholic Church** in Mardin- It was once the Metropolitan cathedral of the **Chaldean Catholic Eparchy of Mardin**, prior to it lapsing in 1941. Nevertheless, One Chaldean family remains to maintain it.^[29]
- Mor Mihail Church -A Syriac Orthodox Church located on the southern edge of Mardin.
- Mor Simuni Church - A Syriac Orthodox Church with a large courtyard.^[30]
- Mor Petrus and Pavlus (SS. Peter and Paul) Church - A 160 year old **Assyrian Protestant Church**, recently renovated.^[31]
- Mor Cercis Church
- **Deyrū'z-Zafaran Monastery** or **The Monastery of St. Ananias** is 5 kilometers southeast of the city. The Syriac Orthodox Saffron Monastery was founded in 493 AD and is one of the oldest monasteries in the world and the largest in Southern Turkey, alongside **Mor Gabriel Monastery**. From 1160 until 1932, it was the seat of the **Syriac Orthodox Patriarch**, until the Patriarchate relocated to the Syrian capital **Damascus**. The site of the monastery itself is said to have been used as a temple by sun worshipers as long ago as 2000 BC.

ATATURK, FOUNDER OF THE TURKISH REPUBLIC AND THE FIRST PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC

Atatürk made many reforms in order to bring Turkey to the level of contemporary civilizations. Those reforms can be put under five main topics:

1. Political Reforms

- Abolishment of the Sultanate (1 November 1922)
- Declaration of the Republic (29 October 1923)
- Abolishment of Caliphate (3 March 1924)

2. Social Reforms

- Women were given equal rights with men (1926-1934)
- The Revolution of Headgear and Outfit (25 November 1925)
- Closing of dervish lodges and shrines (30 November 1925)
- The surname law (21 June 1934)
- Abolishment of nicknames, pious and royal titles (26 November 1934)

- Adoption of the International calendar, time and measurements (1925-1931)

3. Juridical Reforms

- Abolishment of the Canon Law (1924-1937)
- Instating the new Turkish Civil Code and other legislation to suit secular order (1924 - 1937)

4. Educational and Cultural Reforms

- Integration of education (3 March 1924)
- Adoption of the new Turkish alphabet (1 November 1928)
- Establishment of the Turkish Language and Historical Societies (1931-1932)
- Organization of the university education (31 May 1933).
- Innovations in fine arts

5. Economical Reforms

- Abolishment of old taxation laws.
- Encouragement of the farmers.

TURKISH RECIPES FROM STUDENTS

1. Ingredients for **BEYRAN** Soup's Recipe (Gaziantep)

1. 1 kg lamb shank
2. 2 tea glasses of rice
3. 5 ~ 6 cups of water
4. 1 tablespoon of butter
5. 2 teaspoons of pepper paste
6. 2 teaspoons of red paprika
7. 8 cloves of garlic
8. Salt
9. Black pepper

1) First of all, add the lamb meat, peeled garlic and water to the pressure cooker and boil.

2) Chop the boiled meat in small pieces. Add the broth and washed rice and boil the rice.

3) Add butter, tomato paste, chili pepper, salt and pepper and boil for 2-3 minutes. After adding the meats and boiling for 1-2 minutes, remove from the heat. Serve hot. Bon Appetit.

2. "KARNIYARIK"

Necessary ingredients for this dish:

6 small eggplants (if large, you can cut it in half) ,3 long green peppers; For the mortar with minced meat: 2 medium onions, 2 tomatoes, 2 long green peppers, 2 cloves of garlic,

oil, salt, black pepper, red pepper, 200 g ground beef, 1 tea glass of hot water; For the sauce: 1 tablespoon tomato paste, 1 glass of hot water. Now I will explain how to do it: Peel the eggplants and soak them in salt water for half an hour so that they do not absorb oil. Fry the 3 peppers in oil. Then roast the chopped onions in the same pan, add the minced meat and roast it for a while, and add the peppers and garlic for 2 more minutes. Place the eggplants in the tray by cutting the middle and press these cuts into the eggplant to make room for the filling and fill the eggplants with the material.

On the eggplants you fill, divide the cherry tomato that you cut in half or 1 tomato in equal size and put one of the peppers you fried. In a separate place, crush 1 spoon of tomato paste in 1 cup of hot water and pour between the eggplants. Do not pour the minced meat on it so that it does not come out. Then put it in the oven that you have heated at 170 degrees and cook it for 20-25 minutes. It will be cooked in the pot at the same time.

4. MANTI

- Ingredients:
- For the dough
- 3 cups flour
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon of salt

For inside:

- 250 grams of ground beef
- 1 medium onion
- 1 teaspoon of salt
- ½ teaspoon of black pepper
- ½ teaspoon of chilli pepper
- for the sauce
- 2 tablespoon butter
- For the above
- 1 cup of garlic yoghurt
- 1 teaspoon of mint
- 1 teaspoon of red pepper

The first step is to prepare the dough from flour and water. Then cutting dough into small squares piece's. We will fill this pieces with minced meal which we should prepare before by chopping the onions on small pieces, adding black pepper, salt and minced meat all together. After putting this mixture we should close the dough and the meat must be covered. We should put manti into hot water and boil it about fifteen minutes.

For serving we will put boiled manti on the plate and on Yoghurt, red pepper and melted butter on it. Now you can enjoy your food.

5. LAHMACUN Recipe

Ingredients:

The dough: 350 g all purpose flour, single packet instant yeast, 200 ml water, 1 tsp salt, 1 tbsp olive oil.

The topping: 250 g ground beef, 2 tomatoes, 3 cloves of garlic, 3 tbsp finely chopped parsley, 1/4 of a red bell pepper diced, 1/2 a green bell pepper diced, 1/2 tsp water, 1 tsp salt, 1 tsp black pepper, 1 tsp paprika.

Directions:

Finely chop the tomatoes and grate the garlic. Mix well every ingredient you see under the "the topping" category. Let it sit in the fridge until you have your dough ready.

To prepare the dough, mix everything you see under "the dough" category. Knead it well, then cut the dough into 4 equal pieces. Round the pieces, cover with a clean and moist piece of cloth, and rest for 10 minutes.

Spread each dough piece large enough a regular lahmacun. Place the meat topping, and bake for up to 25 minutes (until it's crispy). Bon appetite!

Note: You are recommended to serve it with chopped onion slices, parsley, spices, and lemon.

You can eat this with 4 people or you can eat it alone.

- * 4 tomatoes
- * 1 onion
- * 4 Green greens
- * 2 cucumbers
- * 100 grams of walnuts (although not walnuts)
- 1/2 bunch of parsley
- * 6 tablespoons of oil
- * 4 tablespoons of pomegranate syrup (you can put as much as the spoon we eat and try a tablespoon.)
- 1 teaspoon of sumac (here, but I don't know if it's there, you can replace it with sour powder)

* 1 teaspoon of hot pepper

Chop all the vegetables there. Then take it in a bowl and mix it and put the same amount into it as I said. (Add something to yourself if you want. It's okay.) Gaziantep's salad.

- 1 tomato
- Stuffed green pepper recipe is covered by tomato:
- ½ water glass of Olive oil
- 1 Onion
- 1 clove of garlic
- 1 teaspoon currant
- 2 tablespoons of pine nut
- 1 teaspoon of salt
- 1 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 teaspoon of mint
- 1 glass of hot water

Recipe

- First, chop the onion into small cubes. Then, you should take half a glass of olive oil into a large wok and roast with chopped onion until turn pink. After, into the ground rice, chopped garlic, pine nut, currant, salt, black pepper, mint, and tomato paste is put, mixed. Then add a glass of hot water add to cook on low heat about eight or ten minutes.
- Prepare the dough is stuffed in green peppers issued with top cover and inside. Then, the stuffed green peppers cover with tomato and it aligns upright in saucepan. Fill the saucepan halfway with water and close the saucepan lid. Until rice has swollen and cooking water run out cooks on low heat about thirty or ten five minutes. Finally, serve the stuffed green pepper as warm or cold.



One day the donkey of the Hodja got stolen. The Hodja began to search it. While searching, he


